We certify on the basis of our knowledge and the information given by our suppliers that the glass filaments and glass yarns, which are a subject of production range in our production sites Saint-Gobain ADFORS Cz and Saint Gobain America SA de CV are free of PBB, PBDE, DEHP, BBP, DBP, DIBP. We cannot guarantee that some traces of heavy metals in the quantities of ppm are not detectable in the product as impurities of glass raw materials.
